



High Poverty Area Determination Guidelines

1. Go to the American Fact Finder homepage at www.FactFinder.Census.Gov
2. Find the Address Search section located on the middle right side of the page and click on the Street Address link.



3. Type in the street address, city and state for the youth
4. A table will come up titled Geography Results with a list of geography types (Region, States, County, Congressional Districts, etc.). Census Tract will be the seventh option on the list. Click on the Census Tract hyperlink.



- Next, on the left side of the page, there are search options for Topics, Geographies, Race and Ethnic Groups, Industry Codes and Occupation Codes. Click on the first option Topics.
- A dialogue box will come up and you will need to close it. You may need to scroll up to close the dialogue box.
