By providing peer-to-peer support through the transition process, VTAP works alongside the transitioning service member or spouse to make referrals that address specific needs.

**\*The Virginia Department of Veterans Services\* (DVS)** - advocates for Virginia veterans and connects them to earned benefits and services they have earned. Information on current federal, state and local veterans' programs, entitlements and referral services is available in Virginia through a network of 30 benefit service offices. All services are provided free of charge

**\*Virginia Veterans and Family Support\* (VVFS)** – Resource Specialist that works with veterans and their family members to identify behavioral health, rehabilitative and other services needed

**\*Tidewater Community College\* (TCC)** - We can provide information for active duty, retired or a military dependent on educational benefits that you can use towards your education at TCC. We can help you identify your available benefits and walk you through the process of applying for and using them.

**\*Mission United\*** – Connecting Hampton Roads Military and Veteran Community with local resources and information.

**\*The Virginia Employment Commission\* (VEC)** - Promotes economic growth and stability by delivering and coordinating workforce services.

**\*Financial Coach\*** – Provides one – on – one financial coaching to help you identify your financial goals, create a plan, and track your progress. The financial coaching services are offered at no cost to you and no strings attached.

**\*Old Dominion University\* (ODU)** – Provide assistance to Veterans, Active Duty, Retired and Military Dependents on educational programs at ODU and information on how to navigate and use your VA benefits to reach your educational goal.
