

## PROGRAM YEAR 2019 (PY'19) ONE-STOP OPERATOR PROCUREMENT INFORMATION

The Hampton Roads Workforce Council (HRWC), formerly known as Opportunity Inc. of Hampton Roads, issued RFP # OSO-PY'19-1 on 2/4/19 for Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) One-Stop Operator proposals for the initial period of 7/1/19 to 6/30/20, with the option for up to three (3) annual renewals, thereafter. The RFP was issued in accordance with the applicable WIOA requirements and closed on 3/18/19 with three (3) proposals received.

The Hampton Roads Workforce Board (HRWB) Workforce Services Committee (WSC) met on 4/10/19 in order to review the proposals and formulate a selection recommendation. The proposals were individually rated in accordance with the evaluation criteria set forth in the aforementioned RFP. Based on the WSC review, the unanimous recommendation was for the Workplace, Inc. to be selected as the One-Stop Operator to begin services on 7/1/19 at a first year annual contract amount of up to \$60,000. The HRWC Executive Committee and Local Elected Officials unanimously approved the WSC recommendation to select the Workplace, Inc. as the One-Stop Operator for PY'19 at their meeting of 4/17/19. Based on that action, the HRWC executed a contract with the Workplace, Inc. for PY'19 WIOA One-Stop Operator services at a first year annual cost of up to \$60,000.
