**\*Virginia Veterans and Family Support\* (VVFS)** – Resource Specialist that works with veterans and their family members to identify behavioral health, rehabilitative and other services needed

**\* Old Dominion University (ODU) / Tidewater Community College (TCC) / ECPI University / Regent University (MRC) / Grand Canyon University (GCU) \*-** We can provide information for active duty, retired or a military dependent on educational benefits that you can use towards your educational needs.
